POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

New Registration Procedures:

1. Early Registration will begin **June 22, 2010**.
2. You **may** register for **all three sessions** at once.
3. Lotteries will apply to over-subscribed courses by the close of the **FALL** session registration ending September 21 2010.
 - **Beyond September 21 2010, entry to any course in any session will be on a 'first come, first served' basis. As such, early registrants will have priority.**
 - Individuals who have applied for early registration to Winter and Spring courses (before September 21st, 2010) will be guaranteed a spot unless the course is over-subscribed during the early registration process.

Registration Drop Off – All cheques and application forms can be delivered to the After 4 Box (in the office) OR mailed to: After 4 Committee, c/o Bialik Hebrew Day School, 2760 Bathurst Street, Toronto, ON, M6B 3A1

Payment – **Each course** requires **separate cheques** for **each child** made payable to **"Bialik PTA"**. Please no cash payments. All After 4 payments must be paid in full with submission of the Registration package or your child will be denied entry to the program (and if the program is over-subscribed, the spot will be given to the next child on the list). You may **post-date** cheques to the last date of the relevant registration period. Current dated cheques will be deposited upon receipt.

Cancellations/Course Changes – Any changes or cancellations must be communicated to the After 4 Committee **in writing** or **via e-mail** (after4@bialik.on.ca) and must be made prior to the **last day** of the registration period for each session (as outlined above). Any cancellations beyond those dates will be subject to a \$50 administrative fee up to the end of the **first week** of courses. No changes/refunds will be made following the first week of programs. **Please note: Each program has a minimum and maximum**

registration requirement. Any program that does not meet it; minimum registration will be cancelled and you will be notified.

Child Pick Up Routine – Children are to be picked up **directly** from their program location and signed out by the course instructor. Please attach a list of individuals who are authorized to pick up your child.

Late Pick Up Fees - Late pick up fees of \$1/minute will apply and must be paid on pick up directly to course instructor. CHILDREN WILL NOT BE ADMITTED TO SUBSEQUENT CLASSES UNTIL THE LATE FEE IS PAID.

Babysitting - There will be **NO** After 4 babysitting on any day. Any or all child care needs must go directly through Sabrina's "After School Babysitting". Please contact Sabrina at sabrina_barczynski@bialik.on.ca.
